16-19 Bursary Fund Guidelines and Application Form 2019-20

The 16 to 19 Bursary Fund

The 16 to 19 Bursary Fund was introduced in 2011 and is money the government has given to local authorities, schools, colleges and other education and training providers to provide financial support to help students overcome specific barriers to participation, so they can remain in education.

Bursary Fund

Epsom and Ewell High School will target the 16-19 Bursary fund to ensure that it reaches students who face significant barriers to participating in education and will target funds to help the students in greatest need. (See categories 1-4 on the application form). Eligible students could receive an annual bursary of up to £1,200.

Discretionary fund

Students who are not eligible for the Bursary Fund can apply to the Discretionary Fund for support for course specific educational visits and residential trips, educational materials such as books & equipment, university application (UCAS) fees and transport costs if an Oyster card is not available.

Eligibility will be determined via formal application and will provide for students who are not covered by the Bursary Fund. We will then look at income related eligibility (see categories 5-6 on the application form). Priority will be given to those who are eligible for Free School Meals and where the current household income is no more than £30,500. The amount provided will be dependent on the funding received by the school.

Application Process and Payments

All applications are to be made to the Sixth Form Office, along with the required evidence. Applications for should be received by 27th September 2019. Throughout the year applications will be considered subject to funds being available.

We will process the information and advise you, in writing of the outcome. All eligible payments will be subject to the conditions laid down in the Sixth Form Contract and will be attendance related.

Students who are eligible for the Bursary Fund will be paid once a term into their bank account. Discretionary payments will be paid on application.

Please note that Epsom and Ewell High School guarantees that all personal information, including band details and household earnings, will be stored securely and will remain strictly confidential.

Please ensure that you have read and understood the school's statement regarding bursary applications before completing this form. Please note that if a bursary is awarded the payments will be subject to the conditions of the 16-19 Bursary Fund Contract being met.
